

PROBLEM

Unconscious racial bias, exclusion and discrimination are present in Hong Kong society.

Our main goal is to address the lack of equitable global education access in Hong Kong schools due to social inequality and ethnic segregation, and thus contribute to the UN Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) #4 - Quality Education. With an emphasis on SDG #4.7, we work provide education on sustainable lifestyles, human rights, gender equality, a culture of peace and non-violence, global citizenship, and appreciation of cultural diversity and its contributions to sustainable development. ICE is a signatory of the Racial Diversity & Inclusion Charter for Employers issued by the Equal Opportunities Commission.

Multinational corporations in Hong Kong are comprised of skilled talented expats from around the world, who can become part of the solution to social integration, while further boosting the DEIB awareness in the workplace.

What are the volunteering programmes like?

We organise events and workshops for different schools in Kowloon, New Territories or Hong Kong Island. Our customers range from local primary schools to corporate and NGOs. Topics can vary depending on the audience. In the past, topics have included Stereotypes, Myths and Legends, Cuisine and Festivals, and Ethics and Justice.



ROLE AS CULTURAL SHARER

The standard format for a session will be a cultural presentation followed by interactive activities. During these sessions we expect our Cultural Sharers to:

- Give short presentations on the lesson topic
- Relate presentations to their country of origin
- Conduct casual conversations with participants about their experiences
- At certain events, decorate booths to showcase their countries


